

Listed below are the items in the attached photos and how to dispose of each one. (from top left down in columns)

- Peppermint box = recycle
- Steel food can = recycle with lid inside the can
- Berry container = check number inside chasing arrows, if it <u>isn't</u> a 4 or 6, recycle (if 4 or 6, landfill)
- Napkins/Paper towels = compost; if paper towels were used for cleaning, landfill (because of cleaning chemicals)
- Ajax can = landfill (mixed materials)
- Plastic cup with lid and straw = recycle cup, landfill lid and straw
- Plastic cupcake container? = check number inside chasing arrows, if it <u>isn't</u> a 4 or 6, recycle (if 4 or 6, landfill)
- Plastic cups, plates, and silverware = plastic utensils, landfill (too small); plastic plates and cups, refer to number in chasing arrows; if chasing arrows cannot be found, landfill (when in doubt, throw it out)
- Paper cup = depends, unless you are sure it is wax-lined, landfill
- Protein shake container/broth container = recycle (Tetra Pak is the brand name, aseptic container is the general term)
- Lotion with pump = leave pump attached and recycle
- Pizza box = if from frozen pizza, recycle; if from take-out pizza and contaminated with oils/grease, compost
- Olive oil container = recycle with lid attached
- Gatorade bottle = recycle with lid attached
- Milk jug = recycle with lid attached; paper milk cartons are also recyclable (even with the little plastic spout)
