- The first president of the United States, [George Washington](#), was inaugurated on April 30, 1789
- April is the equivalent of October in the Southern Hemisphere.
- The phrase "April Showers bring May Flowers" comes from a poem from the 1500s by Thomas Tusser.
- The April full moon earns the name April's Full Pink Moon not due to its color but because it's named after the pink phlox flowers that bloom in North America's early spring.
- Some of the famous people with an April birthday are Queen Elizabeth II, Leonardo da Vinci, Charlie Chaplin, William Shakespeare, Thomas Jefferson, and Jackie Chan.

April is the **fourth month of the year** and has **30 days**. It is known for its springtime weather, the birthstone of **diamond**, and the birth flowers of **daisy and sweet pea**.
